On completion of this first step you will be aware of what is involved in preparing and maintaining a surface that allows maximum playability for the season. (Lunch provided)

Some of the subjects covered on this course

- ✓ The definition and assessment of surface
- ✓ Early spring maintenance for cricket pitches
- ✓ Mowing, scarification and brushing
- ✓ Irrigation, rolling and fertiliser application
- ✓ Preparation of the square and match pitch
- ✓ Turf problems; weeds, pests and diseases
- ✓ Safe and effective use of equipment
